

## 21st Annual Unregistered Baptist Fellowship National Meeting To be Held at the Life Center of Southport, Home of the Indianapolis Baptist Temple

The 21st Annual National Meeting of the Unregistered Baptist Fellowship will be held October 9-11, 2006 at the Life Center of Southport, the new home of the Indianapolis Baptist Temple. Greg A. Dixon will be the Host Pastor for this historic event.

Since the raid on IBT February 13, 2001, the congregation has not had a permanent place to worship. Finally a suitable building was located, and after much



hard work, the grand opening will be held September 10 at 9:30 a.m. The Life Center is located at 4002 East Southport Rd, Indianapolis, Indiana, two blocks west of I-65 South (exit 103).

Featured speakers at the National Meeting will include John Bishop, founder of "God Is So Good Ministries;" Baptist historian James R. Beller; and Jerald Finney, Lead Counsel for the Biblical Law Center.

**John Bishop:** "God is always good, and God is always right." These are the watchwords of evangelist John Bishop, founder of "God Is So Good Ministries," who says his goal is "to help the brokenhearted and hurting people of this world to see God's goodness and righteousness." A serious bout with aseptic meningitis in 1995 left John with severe physical limitations and with no memory of his previous life. His wife Donna remained by his side to help him, even when he did not remember being married to her. He had to re-learn to perform basic functions such as walking, talking, reading and writing. Pain and headaches remain a daily battle even today. John and Donna live in the small town of Rose Bud, Arkansas, and are members of Gospel Light Baptist Church. When they are not evangelizing on the road, they also minister to young people through Triple S Christian Ranch.

**James R. Beller:** A native of St. Louis, Missouri, James Beller grew up on the South Side and attended St. Pius V grade school. In his high school days, the author was born again after reading Gospel tracts that had been given to his mother. Four years later, while attending a local state university, he surren-

## Political Activity Compliance Initiative Now a Reality

That stranger seated next to you in church taking notes may be from the government.

The Internal Revenue Service has recently announced that they now have a special division called the Political Activity Compliance Initiative to monitor preacher's sermons to determine that they do not violate their 501(c)(3) tax-exempt charter by delving into partisan politics.

Following a recent upturn in politicking by non-profits, the IRS launched its new enforcement program to investigate allegations of wrongdoing. News releases and notices were sent to more than 15,000 tax-exempt organizations, numerous church denominations and tax preparers.

Under the program, the IRS will no longer wait for an annual tax return to be filed or the tax year to end before investigating allegations of wrongful campaigning. A "referral" could be submitted by a member of the public or by an agent. A three-member committee will review the referral, then vote on whether to investigate. Three levels of violation have been established, ranging from a one-time inadvertent incident that would be remedied with a threatening letter, to a "egregious and repetitive" violation that would be fully prosecuted.

"While the vast majority of charities and churches do not engage in politicking, an increasing number did take part in prohibited activities in the 2004 election cycle," IRS Commissioner Mark W. Everson said in a statement. "The rule against political campaign intervention by charities and churches is long established. We are stepping up our efforts to enforce it."

This prohibition means 501(c)(3) organizations may not endorse candidates, distribute statements for or against candidates, raise funds for or donate to candidates or become involved in any activity that would be either supportive or opposed

## Executive Order 13397 Church As Governmental Agency

*The White House – Office of the Press Secretary – March 7, 2006*

### **Executive Order: Responsibilities of the Department of Homeland Security with Respect to Faith-Based and Community Initiatives**

By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and the laws of the United States of America, and in order to help the Federal Government coordinate a national effort to expand opportunities for faith-based and other community organizations and to strengthen their capacity to better meet America's social and community needs, it is hereby ordered as follows:

#### **Section 1. Establishment of a Center for Faith-Based and Community Initiatives at the Department of Homeland Security.**

(a) The Secretary of Homeland Security (Secretary) shall establish within the Department of Homeland Security (Department) a Center for Faith-Based and Community Initiatives (Center). . .

# Marion County Sheriff gets \$50,000 Boost

*Contract was changed to aid Anderson, the highest paid public official in state*

Above was the lead headline in the *Indianapolis Star* when Sheriff Frank Anderson awoke on Tuesday morning July 11. The Sheriff, who as a Federal Marshal led the raid on the Indianapolis Baptist Temple on February 13, 2001, was quietly handed a \$50,000 boost to his current \$360,000 salary.

By Wednesday July 12, however, Sheriff Anderson announced that he was giving the money back because of public pressure.

The article revealed that Anderson holds the most lucrative public job in the state – making three times more than the Governor and nearly as much as President Bush – because Indiana law allows him to keep some of the money his department collects in overdue taxes.

Pictured in the article was Anderson's \$861,000 lakefront home on Geist Reservoir north of Indianapolis.

There is an effort on the part of the Democrat Mayor of Indianapolis, Bart Peterson, to merge the Sheriff's Department with the Police Department. Originally, Anderson vehemently opposed the idea, but later acquiesced when all agreed to allow the Sheriff to be the top dog of both departments.

Anderson said of his \$50,000 bonus, "I should be paid what the law entitles me to be paid." Anderson's lawyers worked out a way that he could receive the money lawfully even though former Republican Sheriff Jack Cottey said that even though he was entitled to it, he had always given it back.

Cottey, who was Sheriff in 2001,

refused to allow his department to participate in the raid against the Baptist Temple even though, according to Cottey, he was asked to help several times by Frank Anderson's U.S. Marshal's office.

When Anderson said that all he wanted was what the law allowed, it brought to mind the fact that that is all the congregation of the Baptist Temple wanted. The law of the land is clear according to the U.S. Constitution – "Congress shall make no law respecting the establishment of religion nor prohibiting the free exercise thereof."

Something that many may not understand is the fact that down through the ages, God has given mankind the choice of Barabbas or Christ over and over again. When Anderson, a Democrat, ran for Sheriff in 2002, the people of Marion County, which is a Republican County, elected the man who led the raid on a church of the Lord Jesus Christ, and according to the polls, they knew exactly what they were doing. *The Star* article made a point to mention that Anderson was widely praised in 2001 in his handling of the standoff at the Indianapolis Baptist Temple as a U.S. marshal.

No doubt in all of this the greatest irony is the fact that President Bush fired Anderson from the U.S. Marshal's office the day after the IBT raid. Anderson could have refused to conduct the raid and resigned his Federal Marshals's post with honor, but he never dreamed that after conducting the "successful" raid that he would have not been allowed to keep his job of over thirty years.

# Creationist Arrested

## *Dr. Kent Hovind charged with tax evasion*

On July 13, 2006, Dr. Kent Hovind, founder of the well-known Creation Science Evangelism ministry, was arrested on federal charges of tax evasion.

A grand jury indicted Dr. Kent Hovind on 58 federal charges, including falsifying bankruptcy documents, filing a false and frivolous lawsuit and complaints against the IRS, destroying records, and threatening to harm IRS investigators. Twelve of the charges are for failing to pay employee-related taxes.

However, Dr. Hovind maintains that he has no employees, and all his workers, who receive cash, are missionaries in the creationism field.

"The laborer is worthy of his hire," Hovind explained. "We try to take the purely scriptural approach. We do the best we can with helping people with their family needs. There are no employees here."

In addition to presenting his popular Creation Science seminars throughout the world, Dr. Hovind, known as "Dr. Dino," has a creationism theme park called "Dinosaur Adventure Land" in Pensacola, Florida.

For 17 years, the IRS has attempted to bring charges against Dr. Hovind. Two years ago, IRS agents raided Hovind's home and Dinosaur Adventure Land to confiscate records. In the current situation, Hovind accuses federal agents of "grand jury shopping," noting three previous grand juries failed to indict him.

This is not Dr. Hovind's first encounter with government persecution. In April of this year, some of the buildings at the Dinosaur Adventure Land were closed by order of Circuit Court Judge David Allen in a dispute with Escambia County (Florida) over permits and building inspections. County officials have been asking the court to allow them to bulldoze the buildings, even though two

engineers and two certified electricians have verified the safety of the structures. Over a 5 year period, over 60,000 people from the US and 70 foreign countries have visited Dinosaur Adventure Land without incident. (Ironically, the National Park Service announced in July that its own Dinosaur National Monument visitor center in Utah had to be shut down indefinitely for "significant life, health and safety issues," according to Mary Risser, superintendent of the Monument.)

The grand jury alleges Hovind failed to pay nearly half-a-million dollars in federal income, Social Security, and Medicare taxes on his employees at his Creation Science Evangelism ministry in Pensacola. Hovind says even though the 30 people who work for him are paid in cash, he is not a tax protestor and is not violating any laws.

Hovind claims his ministry does not have to "render unto Caesar" because it is not working for the government. "Our ministry has been in operation for 17 years," he says. "We don't have any employees, none."

The ministry leader continues his explanation, saying he does not "own anything in the world" but has "dedicated everything to the Lord's work."

One of the charges brought against the Hovinds is that they made bank withdrawals "in a manner that evaded federal requirements for reporting cash transactions." The withdrawals were for sums approximately \$9500, while the starting point for reporting transactions is \$10,000. (Note that if the banks are only required to report \$10,000 transactions, then any withdrawals in any amount below that are perfectly legal and non-reportable. That's like getting arrested for going 64 in a 65 MPH zone, and having the officer tell you that you were trying to evade arrest by going just below the speed limit.)

Dr. Hovind and his wife Jo were released from custody pending trial, but the judge confiscated his passport and firearms and forbade travel outside the court's north Florida jurisdiction, on the pretext that "like-minded people" may help hide the Hovinds.

The case is scheduled for trial in September.

## Government Targets "Paper Terrorists"

Regardless how one feels about the case of U.S. v Kent and Jo Hovind, the following information gleaned from the 15-page government indictment against them should send chills down the spine of every God fearing and patriotic American.

### ***U.S. v. Kent E. Hovind and Jo Hovind***

Kent E. Hovind did corruptly by endeavor [sic] to obstruct and impede the due administration of the internal revenue laws by . . .

- Filing a false and frivolous lawsuit against the IRS in which he demanded damages for criminal trespass and other false allegations during the IRS execution of a lawful court-issued warrant;
- Filing a complaint for a preliminary injunction against an investigating IRS special agent and the Commissioner of the IRS;
- Filing a false complaint against investigating IRS agents with the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration;
- Filing a criminal complaint against investigating IRS special agents falsely alleging among other things, false arrest, false imprisonment, excessive use of force, and theft of property;
- Paying his employees in cash and labeling them "missionaries" rather than employees to avoid payroll tax and Federal Insurance Contributions Act requirements.

It is obvious from these remarks by the U.S. Justice Department that it is now criminal activity in America to use the court system to defend yourself. That very act in itself becomes activity subject to extreme penalties. The government is calling people who use legal means to defend themselves "paper terrorists."

## Will the Preaching on the Blood Atonement and 2nd Coming of Jesus Christ be Outlawed in America?

Texe Marrs tried to warn the pastors and churches of America several years ago. He learned through the IRS attack on his ministry that preaching on the Second Coming of Jesus Christ, based on IRS procedures, was now outlawed in America.

This preacher also has been warning for several years that all churches will also be outlawed if they preach and practice anything but a Roman Catholic definition of Salvation.

These statements are on their way to being embedded into the "law of the land." In a lawsuit brought by Americans United for the Separation of Church and State, Iowa Federal Judge Robert Pratt recently ruled against Chuck Colson's Prison Ministry Fellowship, InnerChange, Inc., a not for profit, Faith Based organization. InnerChange is one of the largest prison ministries in the nation.

Unless overturned on appeal, this decision blocks InnerChange from their prison work, and will in time affect all evangelistic efforts in the prisons of America. In Judge Pratt's June 2006 ruling, he made some of the most outlandish statements ever made by a judge since the founding of our nation.

Pratt stated that evangelicals "tend to be anti-sacramental, which means it downplays the traditional sacramental Christian events – baptism, holy communion or Eucharist, marriage, ordination, etc. – as

appropriate ways to interact or meet with God... Whereas traditional, organized religious groups, such as Roman Catholics, the Greek Orthodox, and Lutherans, employ a structured, highly liturgical style of worship, Evangelical Christian worship is free form with individual pastors given authority to determine how services are planned."

Pratt also ruled:

"The Prison Fellowship and InnerChange belief in the substitutionary and atoning death of Jesus, which reflects a legalistic understanding of the sacrifice of Jesus, likewise, is not shared by many Christians... Belief in the literal, bodily resurrection of Jesus is also not shared by many other, non-Evangelical Christians... Belief in an imminent, personal, and visible second coming of Jesus Christ, as held by Prison Fellowship and InnerChange, does not comport with the belief held by other non-Evangelical Christians that, if a second coming of Christ occurs, its nature is unknown, or is more spiritualized."

Now hear this, preachers of America – Judge Pratt also ruled "...by definition of what is believed – everything they do is construed to convert someone and is therefore unconstitutional."

If this ruling by Judge Pratt is allowed to stand by the higher courts, only the imagination can conjure what is in store for the churches and Christians of our beloved land.

## Three Judge D.C. Panel Rules Against Michael New Case is Still Alive – Barely

As reported in the previous issue of *The Trumpet*, Michael New, the young American soldier who was court-martialed for refusing to wear a United Nations uniform, had appealed his case to the Washington, D.C. Circuit Court of Appeals. The case was heard in February by a three judge panel, who on May 23 ruled against Michael New. New's attorney Herb Titus has asked for an *en banc* hearing, which means that all of the judges on the D.C. Circuit must hear the case.

The decision of these three men, Justices Randolph, Garland and Williams, Senior Judge is summarized as follows: Congress had not ruled the war in Bosnia illegal, as New had argued, therefore the order to wear the U.N. uniform was legal. The court then said that the U.N. insignias were not a uniform, but rather an identifier. The commander had asked New to wear these U.N. patches and hat for the protection of the soldiers.

Hopefully the full *en banc* court will agree to hear the case, and this unsound and harmful ruling will be overturned.

*The Trumpet* also has learned that Congressman Ron Paul (R-Texas) has introduced into the House of Representatives the Citizen Soldier Protection Act of 2006, H.R.4797 to protect America's citizen soldiers.

# Street Preachers Arrested

## *Lawsuit Brings Liberty for Others*

### **Snellville, Georgia**

Two men were arrested while preaching the gospel on the streets of Snellville, Georgia on July 28 when police officers demanded to see a permit for preaching.

Talmadge Holloway, pastor of Holly Springs Mission Church, and Wally Langford were arrested for "demonstrating without a permit."

The two preachers say police left them in a sweltering patrol car for nearly an hour as the temperature climbed into the 90's. City officials say the officers could have taken them to jail, but decided not to.

The preachers contend the charges are unconstitutional, forcing city officials to conduct a review of the permit ordinances. They face fines of up to \$1,000 and 6 months in jail. The court date is set for mid-August.

Holloway intends to return to Snellville to preach. "I was called to do this by God," he said. "I am more afraid of him than I am of them."

### **Atlanta, Georgia**

Bill Ball, Pastor of the Faith Baptist Church in Lithersville, Georgia, was arrested along with four others when they preached against the so-called "Gay Pride" festival in downtown Atlanta on Saturday, June 24.

They preached for about 4 hours outside Piedmont Park, but as they approached the entrance gate, they were told to move to the other side of the street. They refused, since they were already on public property, and others were preaching and distributing tracts in the same area.

Three men were transported in a police cruiser, which stopped along the way to allow the officers to converse with some fellow officers while the handcuffed men suffered in the back of the cruiser without air conditioning.

Bro. Ball related his own experience in a letter: "Bro. Doug Pitts and I remained standing handcuffed on the street corner as if we were on public display in the sweltering heat for 1 hour without water, waiting on transportation to the jail as we watched officers eat popsicles in front of us just to spite us. The Holy Ghost said preach again. So for the next hour, preach we did, handcuffs and all! Surrounded by police officers who we believed that some were lesbians, God prepared a table for us in the presence of our enemies."

Ball and Pitts were eventually transported in a police paddy wagon, where temperatures exceeded 100 degrees. Ball briefly collapsed from dehydration and heat exhaustion.

The five men were kept in Fulton County Jail, where they witnessed to their fellow prisoners, until 5 a.m. the following morning.

All five men were charged with criminal trespass, which carries a maximum penalty of \$1000 or 12 months in jail.

As the "Gay Pride" parade began Sunday, God sent a torrential rain and lightning storm, which flooded the streets with ankle deep water in less than one minute.

### **Harrisburg, Pennsylvania**

In Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, a series of successful lawsuits by preachers against the city brought unprecedented liberty to preach outside their annual "Gay Pride" Festival on July 29.

Several preachers have been arrested at the Festival over the past few years, but legal victories in Federal courts cleared the way for the men to preach freely – even using bullhorns right outside the festival entrance – without police interference.

In July of 2003, four preachers, including Pastor Jim Grove of Heritage Baptist Church in Loganville, PA, were arrested. Charges ranging from disorderly conduct to defiant trespass were eventually dismissed against evangelist James Lyman; Michael Marcavage of Repent-America and Steve Garisto were convicted. Grove was acquitted in Federal court, then successfully sued and won a judgment against the city and the individual

police officers.

The following year, Ron McCrae of the Street Preachers Fellowship was arrested, and also brought suit against the city of Harrisburg, winning an injunction in Federal court.

As a result of the lawsuits, preachers had the freedom to preach unmolested at this year's annual Sodomite event. They had unlimited access to all public areas right up to the festival entrance, were able to pass out tracts, hold signs and banners, and use bullhorns for amplification.

### **Red Lion, Pennsylvania**

The small town of Red Lion, Pennsylvania has obviously not been reading the local papers regarding Pastor Jim Grove's recent legal victories.

The pastor of Heritage Baptist Church took a small band of church members to preach at a street fair in Red Lion on Saturday, August 12. For the second year in a row, the event coordinator (who, despite bearing the name "Sholom," has no peace with God) took umbrage to the preaching. In 2005, the regional police force wisely would not respond to her complaints; this year, they foolishly let her talk them into attempting to shut the preaching down.

*Trumpet* Associate Editor Patricia Stegman was arrested while videotaping the conversation between two officers and Pastor Grove. One officer pointed at the camera, stating, "You have to turn the camera off." When she declined, the second officer attempted unsuccessfully to confiscate the camera, and then charged into her, forcibly restrained her, and led her away in handcuffs.

Originally considering a felony charge of assault, police eventually settled on summary harrasment. Ironically, the videotape which the officer tried to prevent her from recording was then seized by the police department for their own use in prosecuting the case.

Despite the arrest, the preaching resumed without further interference. Sister Stegman was later released and is awaiting a hearing date.

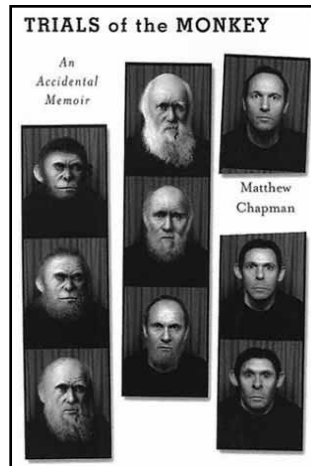

message was complete, Mr. Chapman's English knickers were twisted rather tightly. Chapman took Bro. Hovind's offering as a direct personal attack upon his great great grandfather. He was not a happy camper.

# Richard Mooneyhan Hospitalized

## *Effects of Stroke Will Require Lengthy Rehabilitation*

Richard Mooneyhan, 58, of Ocala, Florida, suffered a massive stroke on August 6.

The stroke was classified by neurologists at Monroe Regional Hospital in Ocala as a "bleeder" type rather than a clot type. Bro. Mooneyhan was sedated and placed on a respirator for several days while doctors in the Neuro ICU fought to control his blood pressure, fever, and brain swelling.

It was feared that he would need a trachostomy to breathe and a feeding tube. Many prayers were lifted on his behalf, and God has faithfully answered them. The respirator has been removed, and he is breathing on his own and able to eat soft foods.

Bro. Mooneyhan was moved to Shands Rehab Hospital in Gainesville on August 18 to begin physical therapy. His left side is paralyzed; although some sensation is returning, he is unable to voluntarily move his left side. He is able to speak clearly and his cognitive skills appear to be unimpaired, although his personality is altered somewhat. Doctors say there is a "dead" spot in his brain, and he likely faces a very long and expensive rehabilitation process.

The stroke occurred while singing with a quartet in a concert. He had organized the quartet a few months ago and had already received acclaim from many quarters.

Richard and Anna Rose have 4 children – sons Doug, Andy, and Jon, and daughter Melody Force – and 13 grandchildren. Family members have rallied to help care for Richard during his rehabilitation and recovery.

Many prayers have already been

answered, amazing the doctors at his rate of recovery. But there is much work ahead, and the Mooneyhan family will need to be strengthened and upheld in prayer as they continue to walk in faith.

Two weeks in the Neuro ICU, and now facing a lengthy rehabilitation without medical insurance, has placed a heavy financial burden on the Mooneyhan family.

to any candidate. Forums designed to educate a church's membership about candidates or issues are allowed only if opposing parties are represented. This means if a church invites a Christian politician to speak at their church, they must also invite a politician who represents Devil.

The IRS has investigated more than 200 organizations nationwide since 2004, and more than 100 cases are currently pending, including 40 churches. Some organizations found in violation were assessed an excise tax, and 3 lost their non-profit status.

IRS rules regarding "political" activities are vague, and are investigated and enforced inconsistently. The code bans nonprofits from "participating or intervening" for "any candidate for public office," including endorsements, donations and fundraising. Nonprofits are allowed to speak out on issues of public interest as long as "a substantial part of the organization's activities is not intended to influence legislation."

What the church considers a spiritual issue, the IRS considers a political issue. What the church considers to be shining the light on the truth, the IRS considers to be "intervening for a candidate." What the church considers to be rebuking or exhorting, the IRS considers to be "influencing legislation."

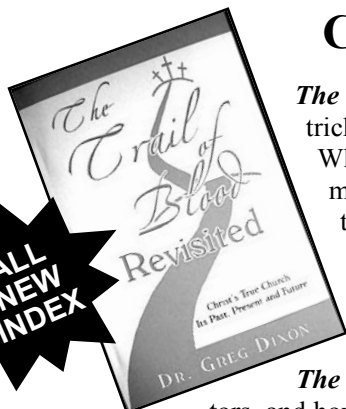
